LEVEL UP FAST - COMPLETE DAILY AND WEEKLY TASKS

One of the most easy ways to level up quickly in Fortnite is to accomplish your weekly quests, which are usually released every Thursday and consist of 7 particular activities to fulfill in the Battle Royale mode. Each mission will award 20,000 XP upon completion, allowing players to acquire a total of 140,000 XP per week simply by completing the weekly quests. Players can accomplish all available quests at any time during the season.

In addition to completing the weekly tasks, the daily tasks also serves as a way to level up quickly. Every day, players are offered three daily quests, each with a reward of 1,000 XP when completed. The quests themselves are rather easy, ranging from acquiring 100 shields to upgrading weapons at an Upgrade Bench. As an advantage, gamers who party up with friends can share Daily Quests, making them easier to finish in a short amount of time. Subsequently, after completing their daily quests, players receive a 15,000 XP daily bonus, for a total of 48,000 XP per day.

QUEST GUIDE PART ONE (1-2)

When doing these tasks, it's critical that you monitor the Paradise questline because you'll need to go to various locations all over the map. If you've tracked the quest, the game will automatically tell you where you can go to accomplish them anytime you access the map.

Hover over a quest and press the 'track quest' button to track it; you can untrack and retrack it at any time.

You'll need to persuade AMIE to build you a translator, which you can do by offering her some electronic parts. The number of pieces obtained from wrecking a vehicle is unpredictable; you may obtain all three at once or only one. Place all of the parts you acquired near one of the odd Reality Tree root sites. When you get close enough, you'll find a location where you can execute this.

QUEST GUIDE PART ONE (2-2)

Wait for further orders, then speak with Blackheart regarding the Scientist's notes. To speak with Blackheart, travel to Lustrous Lagoon and board the ship. Finally, locate and recover the Scientist's stolen research notes.

The Syndicate Shoals landmark is located east of Lustrous Lagoon on a small island. Dig up the dirt mounds scattered over the island with your pickaxe until you find the Scientist's notes.

Destroy Chrome objects in a Chrome-covered biome; you can also destroy structures. Chrome anomalies will occasionally appear after destruction and can be recovered. Repeat until you have a total of five.



BEST DROP LOCATIONS

- Lustrous Lagoon
Everything you need is here, there's plenty of cover with the surrounding ocean and steep rocks to hide behind and under.
- Edge of the map close to greasy grove
The specific island is tough to locate, and it's also doubtful that you'll find it unless you intend to go there.
- Reality Tree
It's difficult to predict whether or not the Reality Tree will be extremely busy.
- Bridge next to shifty shafts
The Whiplash that usually spawns here is the best part of this landing spot.
- Structures near Fort Jonesy
The area around Fort Jonesy is packed with loot and excellent cover. It's tucked away in the trees, with two massive landmarks nearby.
